Adopt A Street Program



*To promote clean streets and beautiful
neighborhoods through environmental
preservation and civic responsibility.*

Program Information

What is Adopt-A-Street?

Mission's Adopt-A-Street program enables community and civic organizations, private businesses, and churches to participate directly in enhancing the overall appearance of our city.

In return for conducting scheduled clean-ups of that section of street four times a year for two years, the sponsors are recognized with signs located at the beginning and end of their designated street section.

Who Can Adopt-A-Street?

Any interested group that has the enthusiasm and dedication to make our community a better place to live can adopt a street.

- Neighborhood Associations
- Community & Civic Organizations

What Do Volunteers Do?

Groups make a commitment to remove litter along pre-designated sections of city streets a minimum of four times per year for a two-year period. Volunteers are encouraged to monitor conditions on their section of city street throughout their adoption period. Any issues should be reported to city staff.

The Adoption Process?

1. Contact the Neighborhood Services Division at (913) 676-8360 and ask to speak with a Neighborhood Services Officer.
2. Obtain, fill out, sign, and return the "Adopt A Street Application Form".
3. Completed forms are then reviewed and processed by Neighborhood Services staff.
4. If approved, Neighborhood Services will schedule a time for the coordinator to come in and review the programs requirements and safety protocols.
5. Prior to all clean-up events, the group coordinator will advise staff of the event date & approximate number of volunteers.
6. The group coordinator is responsible for all volunteers to sign a required waiver, pick up gloves, bags, vests, and other supplies, which are provided by the city.
7. The completed Volunteer Participation Form and waivers must be delivered to City Hall within 48 hours of the completed event date.

Acknowledgement & Recognition

Participants in the Adopt-A-Street program will be recognized on signs located at the beginning and end of their adopted street section. The signs will have the Adopt-A-Street program logo, City of Mission logo, and the volunteer group's name appearing on the sign.

Signs will be installed after the group's first clean-up event has been held, and will remain in place for the designated adoption period for two years.
