

Standard & Poor's Upgrades City of Mission Bond Rating

We received the news yesterday that Standard and Poor's has upgraded the City's overall bond rating and rating for the 2019A issue from AA to AA+. The final report should be available Monday in advance of the bond sale on Wednesday morning. This is great news for the City, and reflects a lot of hard work on the part of various Councils and staff to manage Mission's finances. The upgrade is estimated to save the City approximately \$30,000 over the life of the 2019A bond issue.


Construction Updates

Broadmoor—The contractor has been installing storm water structures and we still anticipating AT&T will be back on site next week to coordinate the relocation of fiber that is in conflict.

Foxridge Patching—The large patching project on Foxridge will begin on Monday. Lanes will be reduced/re-routed during the work, but the roadway will remain open throughout construction.
